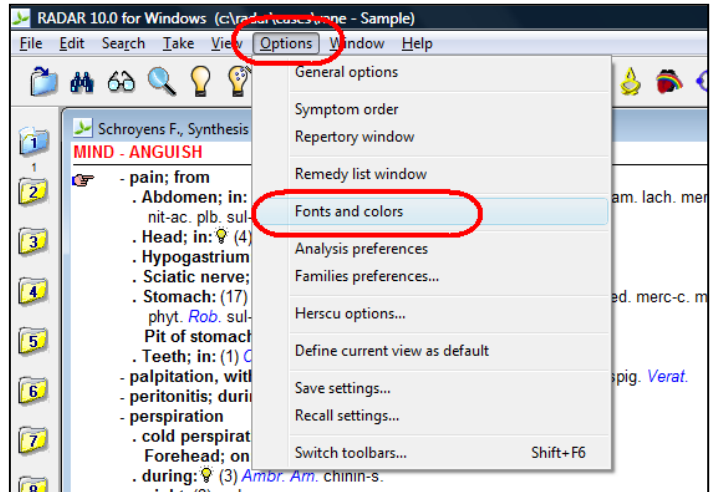


Synthesis: change font size in the repertory for teaching

This manual discusses how to change the font size of the repertory when teaching for a group of e.g. 20-30 persons, or when for a larger room e.g. 60-80 students.

Step 1:

Select: **Options**, then **Font and colors**



Step 2: In the window of Fonts and colors, you need to do the following:

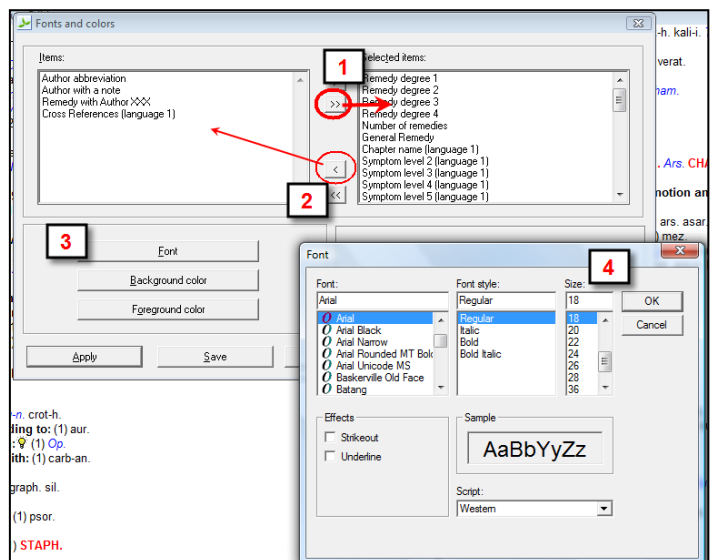
1st: First select all items with the double arrow >> to the right side.

2nd: Not everything needs to become large, so de-select the following 4 items again with the single arrow < to the left:

- Author abbreviation
- Author with a note
- Remedies with Author reference
- Cross References language 1

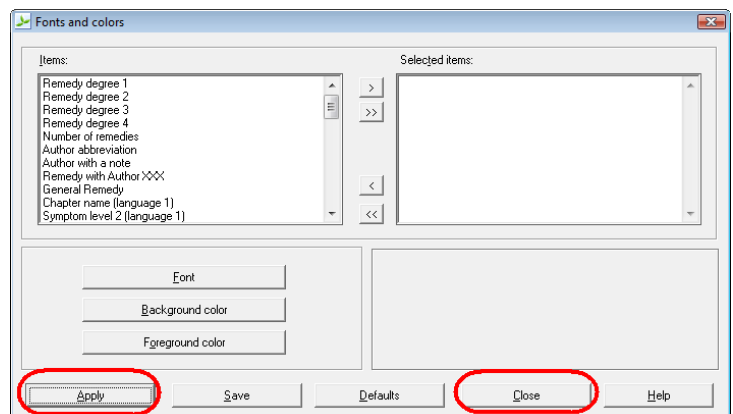
3rd: Click on the button Font

4th: There you select, or type yourself e.g. 18 (for a small class room), or for example 22 (for a larger room 60-80 participants), then select OK.



Step 3:

Then click on 'Apply', then 'Close'.



Step 4:

If you are satisfied with the settings, you can save them via the menu **Option**, then **Save settings**.

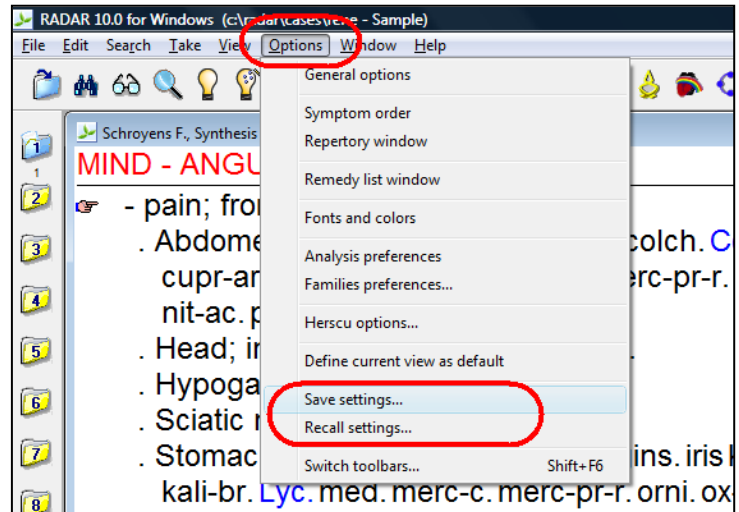
Use for example a name:

Teaching font 18

You can then also save one with:

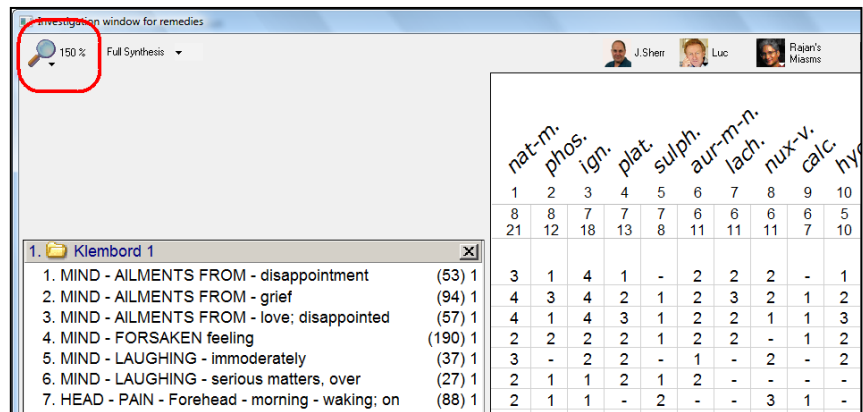
Teaching font 22

When you need these settings later on, you only need to do: **Options, Recall settings**



The analysis

You can also enlarge the analysis window with the % button.



Encyclopedia

In the encyclopedia you can use the buttons **A** and **A** to adjust the font size.

Remember, the for the audience in the last row you really must make it very large !
