

Installing Radar on a USB memory stick

Insert your memory stick of a capacity of at least 8 Gb in a USB port.

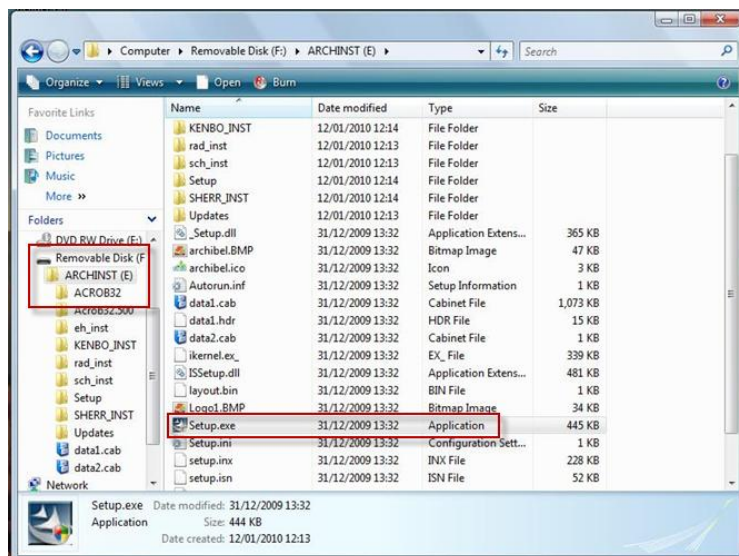
Insert the Radar installation CD in the CD/DVD drive keeping your finger on the Shift key for 60 seconds to stop the installation program from starting. If the installation program does start, wait for it to run through the configuration for the new installation. Once the Archibel Products Installation welcome screen is displayed you can press Cancel.

Open the Windows explorer

Navigate to your CD/DVD drive (E:)

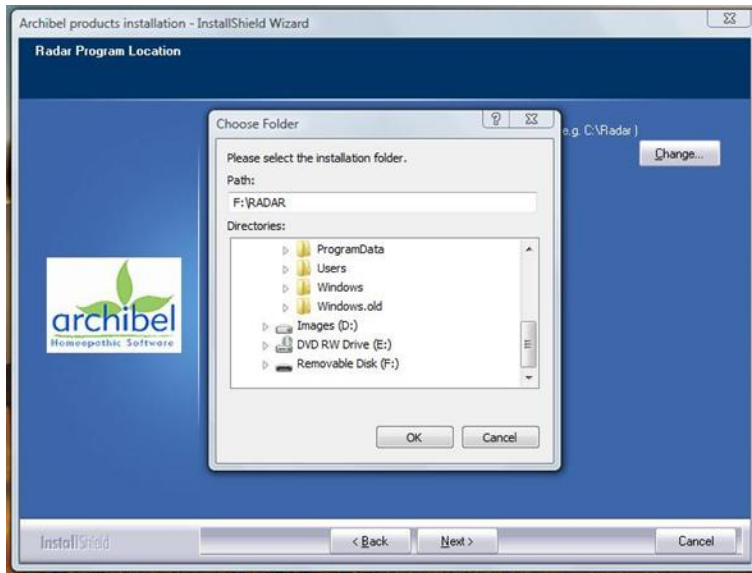
Copy the whole contents of the installation CD and paste them onto your Removable Disk (memory stick)

Navigate to the Removable Disk (memory stick) Archinst folder and execute the Setup.exe file to start the installation program.

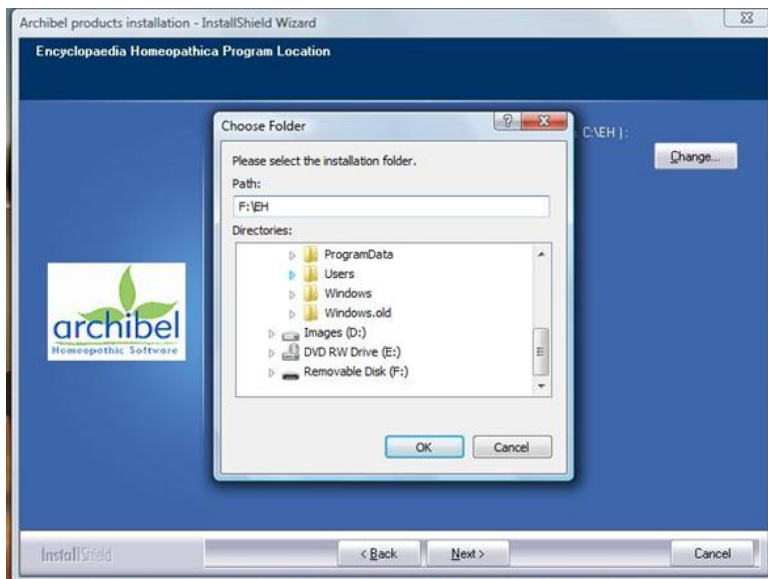


Let the installation program run until it reaches Setup Type and choose the Custom installation.

Continue to the Program Location window where you must click on Change and browse to choose the removable disk (memory stick) and create the folder. For example F:\Radar



Then you must do the same for EH, example F:\EH



Continue the installation following the instructions on screen. Once the installation has finished with the live update you will notice that icons for the Radar, EH and WinChip programs have been created on the desktop (also Kenbo, Scholten and Jeremy Sherr if you have purchased these modules).

Insert your Radar connector and you can start the programs from the desktop icons. Note that WinChip will ask you to confirm the paths for Radar and EH. Browse to set the paths for the radar and eh exe files.

You may use the removable disk with your programs on another computer. However you will need to start the programs via the Windows explorer. To start Radar, navigate to \Radar\Bin and execute the radar.exe file. For EH navigate to the \EH folder and execute EH.exe and for WinChip navigate to \Radar\WinChip\Bin and execute the winchip.exe file.
